Sister Sally Duffy, SC is a Sister of Charity of Cincinnati since 1977 and was President/CEO of the SC Ministry Foundation from 2004 to 2017. Sally has served in various administrative capacities including hospital President/CEO and VP Student Affairs/Dean of Students. Sally's current board service includes: TriHealth System, Catholic Legal Immigration Network, Inc., US Catholic Sisters Against Human Trafficking (founding board member), Ohio Justice and Policy Center, Greater Cincinnati Port Authority, and Price Hill Will (founding board member). Sally also serves on LISC Advisory Board, Advisory Board for Pastoral Migration of the Archdiocese of Chicago, Archdiocese of Cincinnati Immigration Task Force, United Way Policy Committee, Price Hill Safety Community Action Team, and the City of Cincinnati's Gender Equity Committee. Sally is Chair of the Child Poverty Collaborative with the goal of reducing 10,000 children in poverty and 5000 adults in Cincinnati, Ohio. In February of 2017 Sally completed four years as the chair of FADICA (Foundations and Donors Interested in Catholic Activities) and her nine year term on the board. Sally's degrees include: M. Ed., M. PA and M. Div.

Recent honors include: 2019 Working in Neighborhoods Hall of Fame, 2019 Florence Nightingale Ax Award from TriHealth, 2019 Christian Golder Award from the Bethesda Medical Staff, 2018 Graduate Commencement speaker for Xavier University and received an honorary doctorate degree from Xavier University, 2018 Ohio Senior Citizen Hall of Fame, FADICA Charles Carroll Award in Catholic Philanthropy, 2017 Katherine Drexel Award for Catholic Philanthropy, 2017 YWCA Cincinnati Career Women of Achievement, 2017 Cincinnati Enquirer Women of the Year, 2018 Lifetime Achievement from Cincinnati Invest in Neighborhoods, 2008 Doctor of Humane Letters from the College of Mount Saint Joseph, Recognition of Appreciation from the Leadership Conference of Women Religious, and Co-Executive Producer of the Gabriel Award documentary "We Shall Not Be Moved: Catholic Sisters of New Orleans."

Sally volunteers since 2002 for the Leukemia & Lymphoma Society through Team in Training with a goal for finding a cure for blood-related cancers. Sally's history includes being selected by the US Olympic Committee as one of the top 50 Women Basketball players in 1970. Sally coached the University of Notre Dame Women's Basketball Team before joining the Sisters of Charity.
