## LIABILITY

- ◆ Artists are responsible for delivery and shipping.
- ◆ Art should be ready to hang.
- ◆ Artwork may be picked up in late September 2022.

## GENERAL TERMS

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- Entrants must be at least 18 years old, reside within 100 miles of Oxford, or have a personal connection with the hospital.
- Each entrant may submit up to three pieces of art.
- All 2D fine art media are accepted, including mixed media, glass, fabric, metal, **original digital**, or wood suitable for wall hanging.
- All entries must be for sale.
- Entries must be the work of the entering artist.
- Art will be displayed with your short description of intent, content, and/or inspiration along with sale price and contact information. Sales will be exclusively between the artists and the buyers. Selected artists will agree to have their work on display for one year.
- The hospital reserves the right to disqualify any work found to be significantly different from the JPEG version submitted for judging or that is not properly framed and ready to hang.
- Pieces selected for a purchase award will become property of the McCullough-Hyde Memorial Hospital. Ten percent (10%) of a purchase award will be retained for the Auxiliary of McCullough-Hyde Memorial Hospital.

## SUBMITTING ENTRIES

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- All entries must be in JPEG format (600 dpi) and emailed to [connie.clements.cc@gmail.com](mailto:connie.clements.cc@gmail.com)
- All entries must be accompanied by the hard copy completed and signed entry form included with this prospectus and a check for the entry fee.
- Entries must be accompanied by a short statement (up to 75 words) about each work. This may include description of content, process, or intent.
