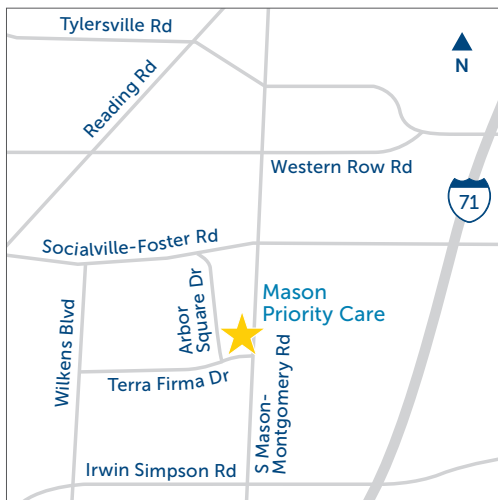
The doctors are now in.
