**Susan Seddoh Nelson, PharmD, MS**

Dr. Susan Seddoh Nelson has her Doctor of Pharmacy and Master of Science with a Specialization in Drug Development and Research degrees from the University of Cincinnati's James L. Winkle College of Pharmacy. She has been a clinical staff pharmacist at Trihealth Rehabilitation Hospital (TRH) for six years. At TRH, Dr. Seddoh Nelson assists in managing patients' medication therapies, participates in team conference rounds to ensure patient medication safety, monitoring and providing recommendations, and serves as the pharmacist on the interdisciplinary Stroke and CHF Committees.

Prior to TRH, she was a Clinical Research Director and Research Pharmacist at the University of Cincinnati's NIH funded department, StrokeNet, and was involved in multiple stroke clinical trials such as ARCADIA (Atrial Cardiomyopathy and Antithrombotic Drugs in Prevention of Cryptogenic Stroke), a randomized trial of apixaban versus aspirin in patients with cryptogenic stroke who have evidence of atrial cardiopathy without atrial fibrillation and MOST (Multi-Arm Optimization of Stroke Thrombolysis), which studied whether combining tPA with either argatroban or eptifibatide produced better results in stroke patients in the first 90 days after a stroke versus tPA with placebo. During her spare time, Dr. Seddoh Nelson enjoys spending time with her family traveling, bike riding, playing the piano and keeping up with her energetic 7 year old daughter.
