Casey Robinson is the current Nurse Educator for the neuroscience critical care department at TriHealth's Good Samaritan Hospital. After graduating from The Ohio State University with her BSN, she worked as a staff nurse and preceptor at the University of Cincinnati's Surgery & Trauma ICU for five years. After earning her CCRN, she attended Xavier University for her MSN in Nursing Education and graduated in 2021. Casey started her Nurse Educator career at Good Samaritan shortly after where she went on to obtain her SCRN and ENLS certifications. Since her time as educator, she has helped Good Samaritan recertify as a Comprehensive Stroke Center and Magnet designated facility, assisted with NSICU staff in continuous renal replacement therapy (CRRT) training, and helped create a program for new graduate nurses in the ICU.
